

Johanne Galipeau's work is colourful and creative, it ranges from small paper collages to large abstract oil paintings




Proletariat Pots 802 Fitzwilliam St

Trevor Whelon will be showing his whimsical driftwood reindeer.






Laura Ewing creates her scenic metal-craft locally, and has many of her pieces on display at this location.




David Burney's work is inspired by the nature surrounding Millstone creek.


